Don't do this	Do this
Illegible handwritten medical records	Make all entries in the medical record legible, in accordance with Medicaid rules. Illegible records reviewed in audits are scored as "not done." See guidance: <u>Documentation Matters.</u>
No referral to WIC	Refer <u>all</u> pregnant, postpartum, and breastfeeding members, and children under 5 years to <u>WIC</u> .
No intimate partner violence (IPV) screening	 Conduct and document IPV screening of birthing members. Refer members who screen positive to <u>Social Services</u>. See guidance: <u>Preventive Services Taskforce</u>.
No maternal depression screening	 Conduct and document <u>Maternal Mental Health</u> screening <u>at least once</u> <u>per trimester and within 6 weeks postpartum</u>: Use <u>EPDS</u> or <u>other approved depression screening tool</u>, and use the tool's scoring instructions. Submit code G8510 (add-on) for <u>negative</u> results. Submit code G8431 (add-on) for <u>positive</u> results and a documented follow-up plan. Refer member to <u>mental health resources</u>, as indicated.
No social needs assessment	 Conduct and document assessment of housing, food, transportation, unintended pregnancy, support system, employment. Make and document referrals to <u>Social Services</u>, as appropriate.
Nutrition and healthy weight gain not discussed or documented	 Discuss and document the following every trimester: Dietary evaluation and guidance Healthy eating habits and weight gain Any needed interventions and referral to <u>WIC.</u>
No dental assessment by OB	 Conduct and document oral (mouth, teeth, gums) assessment by OB at first prenatal visit. Recommend dental care through <u>Medi-Cal Dental</u> and document discussion. See guidance: <u>Oral Health Care During Pregnancy</u>.
Incomplete postpartum assessment	Include and document breast assessment and pelvic exam in the postpartum physical exam. See guidance: Optimizing Postpartum Care.
