

Referring Patients to Home-Based Palliative Care Webinar: June 28, 2022

The questions below were answered privately by our subject matter experts during the webinar. We are sharing the answers with attendees in case they are helpful.

- 1. Can a patient be enrolled with the HBPC program in addition to seeing an outpatient palliative care physician?
 - A Yes. Our home-based palliative care providers can partner with an outpatient palliative care team
- 2. If a patient is seeing an outpatient palliative care physician but only via telehealth, can they be referred to your program?
 - A Yes, they can be referred.
- 3. Is Blue Shield contracted with the PACE Program?
 - **A** No. We do not contract with PACE Programs to provide home-based palliative care services.
- 4. With the expansion of VIDEO visits for palliative clinic, at what point do we transition from clinic-based to home-based palliative?
 - **A** When a patient is struggling with getting to the clinic and has expressed a need for more home-based care, a referral to our program would be called for.
- 5. What is the reimbursement for services provided?
 - A Servicing providers receive a per member per month case rate, which contractually includes the services discussed plus additional expectations.
- 6. Can patients stay on the program indefinitely until they are hospice-eligible?
 - A Yes. There is no time limit as long as the member is clinically eligible.
